

General Comments	The elevation is 8,300 ft.					
	The campground, adjacent to Lake Granby and one of five in the Arapaho National Recreation Area, is composed of three overlapping loops - A, B and C. Loop A winds through a stand of widely spaced Lodgepole pines, while Loop B and C are intermittently open and shaded. Portions of Loops B and C are next to (or in) meadows covered with grass and sagebrush. Most of these sites are in the open with several on the lake shore. Each loo has camp sites with privacy from to fair to good. Tent camping in sites 76 through 83 is not permitted - no tent pads. These sites are well-suited for pop-up tent trailers or other very small RVs. The electric and water hook-u sites are found in Loop A, most of which face the lake but are not on the shore. The wide range of water sports, availability of hot showers and flus toilets and convenience to the Rocky Mountain National Park make this a very popular campground. A portion of Loop A and almost all of the other loops have great views of Lake Granby and mountains in the background. Tents are permitted only on hardened surfaces. Firewood is available from the hosts for a fee.
